- Location appropriateness - think colors, neighbors, messaging as a whole- is it suitable for this specific location?

Dear Board/Committee Member:

The City Attorney's Office will be providing a presentation for members of the City's boards and committees regarding the legal and ethical requirements applicable to public officials serving in municipal government in the State of Florida.

This presentation will review key provisions of Florida law that govern ethical conduct, open government, and public accountability. Topics will include the **Florida Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees (Chapter 112, Florida Statutes)**, the **Florida Sunshine Law (Section 286.011, Florida Statutes)**, and the **Florida Public Records Law (Chapter 119, Florida Statutes)**.

Topics to be covered include:

- Ethical obligations of public officers and board members under **Chapter 112, Florida Statutes**
- Conflicts of interest and voting conflicts
- Disclosure requirements and recusal procedures
- Open meetings requirements under the **Florida Sunshine Law**
- Communications between board members outside of public meetings
- Public records requirements under **Chapter 119, Florida Statutes**
- Retention and disclosure of emails, text messages, and other records related to public business
- Best practices to ensure compliance with Florida's open government laws and to maintain public trust
