RESOLUTION 2026-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS, FLORIDA, RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING THE RESULTS OF THE MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 10, 2026, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Municipal General Election of the City of Tarpon Springs, Florida, was held on the 10th day of March 2026, and

WHEREAS, the candidate for the office of Commissioner Seat 1, David Banther, was unopposed, and pursuant to Section 101.252, Florida Statutes, is by law elected to such office, and

WHEREAS, the names of Va Celia Koumendouros, Craig Lunt, and Lori Weaver appeared on the official ballot as candidates for the office of Commissioner Seat 2, and

WHEREAS, the Pinellas County Canvassing Board has validated and confirmed the election returns for each candidate as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The returns and findings of the Pinellas Canvassing Board be, and the same are hereby ratified and confirmed in all respects.

SECTION 2. David Banther is hereby declared to be legally and lawfully elected to the office of Commissioner Seat 1, for a term of three years commencing April 14, 2026.

SECTION 3. Lori Weaver is hereby declared to be legally and lawfully elected to the office of Commissioner Seat 2, for a term of three years commencing April 14, 2026.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
