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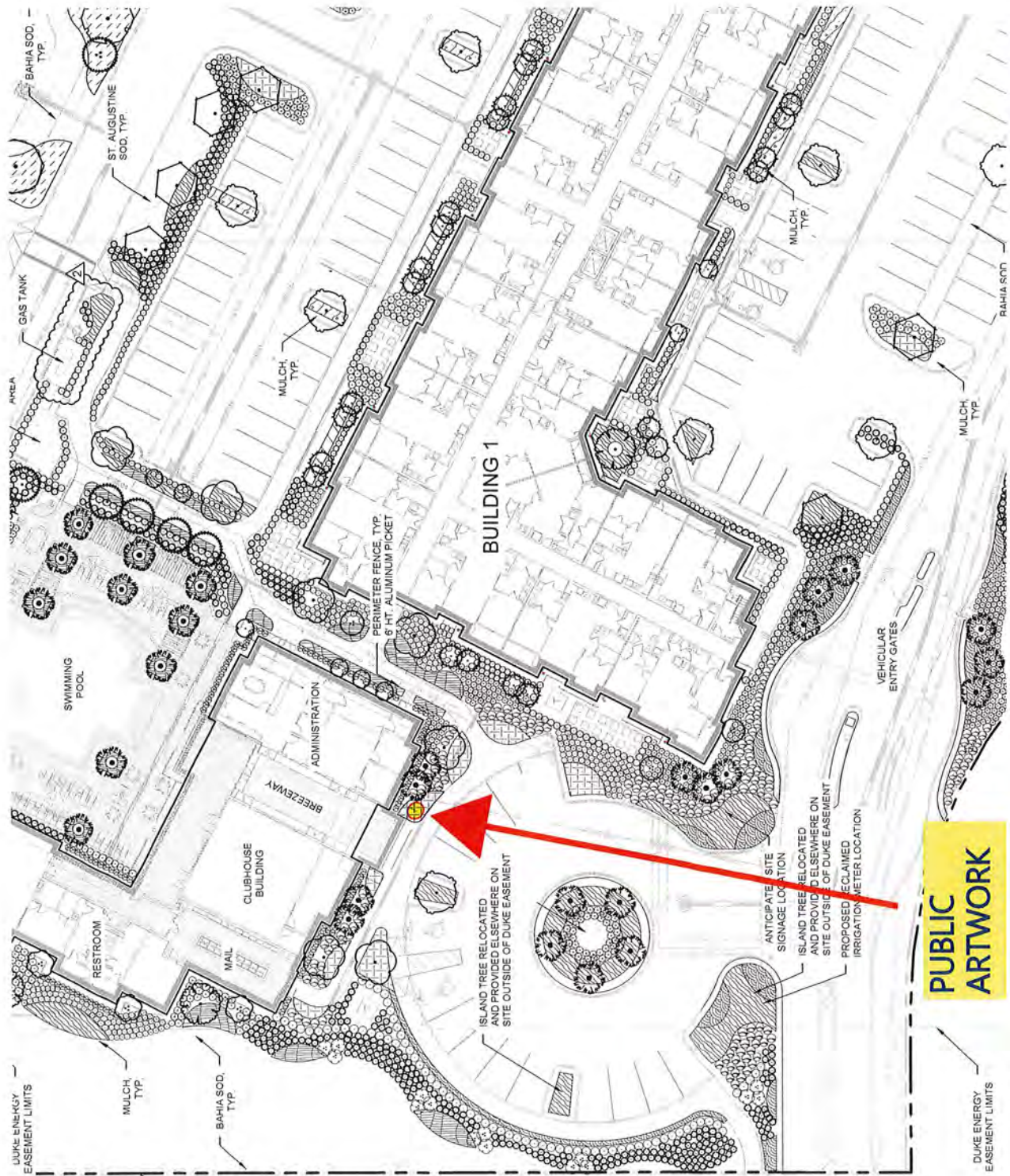


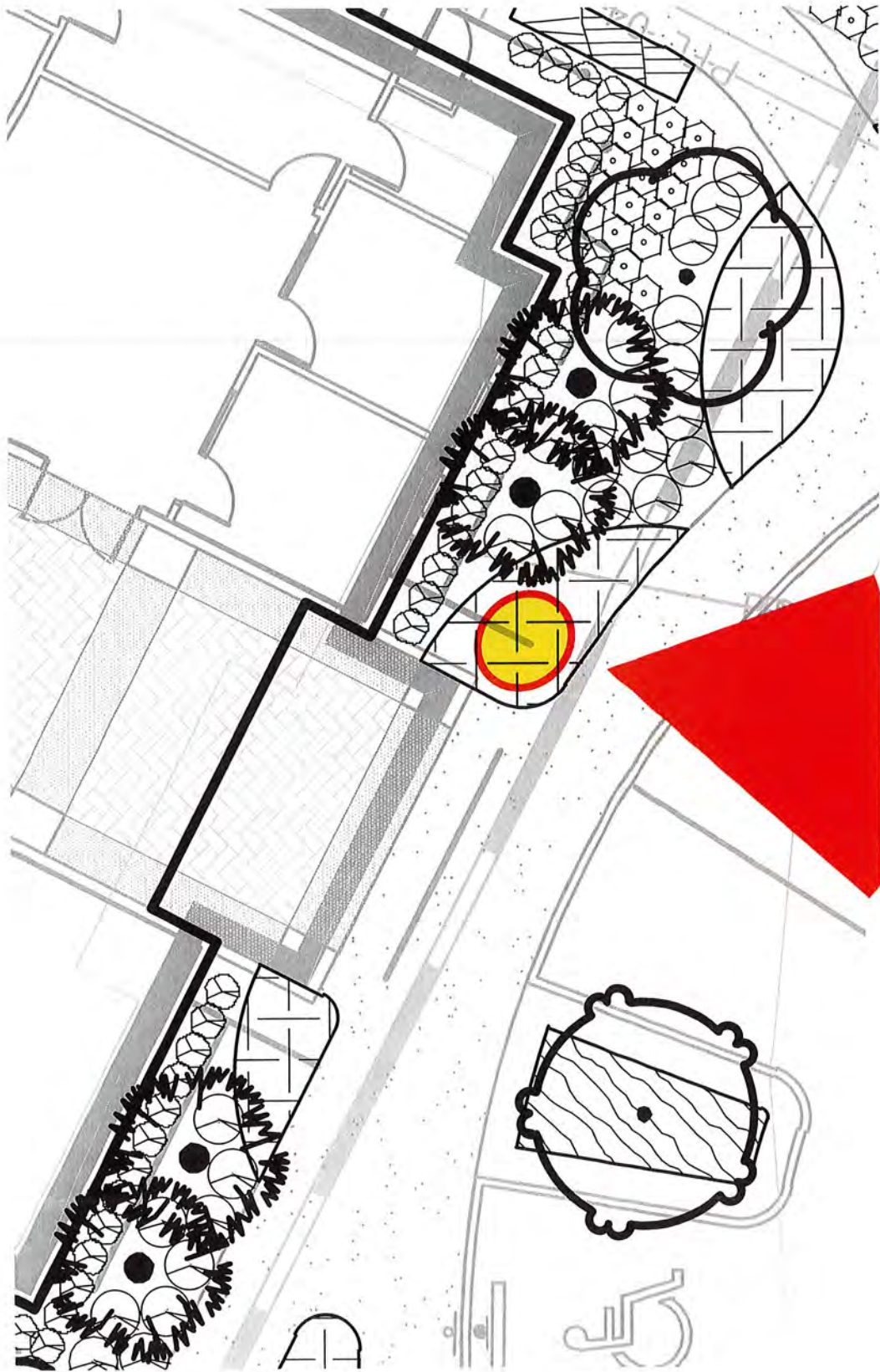

**Subject: Maintenance for Public Art**

Bronze sculptures with a natural style patina (non-pigmented) are a great choice for outdoor artwork. With time, they develop a naturally rich patina of their own. Cleaning and care are recommended to keep them looking spectacular.

Outdoor bronze, we recommend waxing two to four times a year depending on the climate.

**Application Process:**

- ° Wipe the surface area with a clean non-abrasive cotton cloth.
- ° Place a thin coat of wax on the area. We recommend Renaissance Wax or Trewax Brand Carnauba Clear Paste Wax.
- ° After 15-20 minutes buff the sculpture with a clean cotton cloth.

We recommend cleaning your outdoor bronze or stainless steel sculpture with a mixture of water and dish soap using a soft cloth, wipe with a cotton towel to remove debris. Rinse well making sure not to allow the soap to dry. Avoid washing on very hot days or in very bright sunlight (can cause the soap to dry). Be careful to avoid scratching the sculpture.

## Artist Statement

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### Eagle Sculpture for Anclote Harbor

*"You protect what you love, and you love what you're familiar with... what you're connected to."*

For decades, bald eagles have called this stretch of the Anclote River home, raising generation after generation in the towering pines. When large-scale development threatened to change the landscape forever, it was these very eagles that ensured the land remained protected. Their presence was a reminder that this place was more than just a parcel of land—it was part of a thriving ecosystem, home to wildlife that had been here long before roads and buildings.

As an artist, my work has always been about capturing the spirit of nature and inspiring a connection to the world around us. I've had the privilege of creating large-scale public art for commercial properties, municipalities, and institutions—including ongoing work with the White House on their eagle sculptures. Bald eagles have long been a focus of my work, not just as a national symbol, but as living, breathing reminders of resilience and the importance of conservation. When I was given the opportunity to create a sculpture that honors the very eagles who shaped the future of this land, I knew I had to be involved.

This sculpture will depict a larger-than-life eagle's nest, complete with two adult eagles and their young. It represents both the legacy of the eagles who have nested here for years and the promise that they will continue to soar above this landscape. The Morgan Group's commitment to maintaining a protected eagle area, preserving existing trees, and integrating nature into the community is a thoughtful approach—one that offers a far better outcome for the environment than what could have been.

Public art has the power to tell a story, and this sculpture will serve as a lasting tribute to the eagles that safeguarded this land. It is a symbol of balance—the ongoing conversation between progress and preservation, between what we build and what we protect. It stands as a reminder that nature has a place in our communities and that the landscapes we cherish today must be considered as we shape the world of tomorrow.
